I was overall farm manager on a 30-sow herd that grew into 100 sows. The farm also practiced cattle ranching, 250 cows and horticulture production for subsistence purposes. I supervised 24 workers daily to achieve the farms objectives. During this time, I managed to lower the incidence of January disease cases on the farm by enforcing high standards in dipping operations, early identification of sick animals and prompt treatment of sick beasts. I managed to lower the farms piglet and weaner mortalities which helped the farm in growing replacement gilts as opposed to buying in new stock. I managed to kick start recordkeeping as the farm had no prior records. Staff training was also conducted regularly which resulted in smoother as the workers understood what they needed to do and why they had to do it. I also managed to liaise with some marketers for pigs and horticultural produce which produced working capital for the farm. Farm structures were erected for both the cattle section (kraals, fences, feedlot pens etc.) and new pigsties were built to accommodate the growing of the project.
